APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO WORK IN/ON CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY OR PROPERTY



ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The undersigned is applying for a permit to enter in upon and use a portion of City of Yuma property (City property includes, but is not limited to, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, leased or fee land, real estate, utilities and appurtenances; hereafter referred to as "Property"). Applicant acknowledges that inspections will be performed pursuant to City of Yuma Construction Standards and the adopted building code by City of Yuma personnel.

Commercial encroachment permit requests are limited to one specific project per permit. The application must be submitted no more than 60 days in advance of the work, and no less than 10 days prior to start of work. Additionally, the following information is required at the time of application submittal: Schedule, with specific dates of work, duration of work, work hours, contact information for the responsible person, construction plans, and a traffic control plan and cover sheet if work involves traffic control. The City will notify adjacent property and business owners affected by the proposed work, providing the project schedule and the responsible person contact information to call for further information.




THIS APPLICATION is approved with the following directions, requirements and specifications:

- 1. All work performed within City of Yuma (COY) Property shall comply with current COY construction standards and specifications.
- 2. Licensee shall notify COY Engineering Inspection Services (928-373-4506) in advance of beginning work, prior to 3:00 pm per the following schedule:
 - For all commercial encroachment permits, a minimum of <u>72 hours</u> (<u>3 working days</u>) in advance.
 - Work involves closing a public street or alley to vehicular traffic, a minimum of <u>72 hours</u> (<u>3 working days</u>) in advance.
 - For all residential permits, a minimum of 48 hours (2 working days) in advance.
- 3. Open cut of new pavement less than 4 years old in streets or alleys, see Ordinance No. O2019-024 for pavement cut fees.
- 4. Water/sewer taps shall only be inspected Tuesday through Thursday between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm. Contractor will not backfill until the water or sewer lines have been inspected.
- 5. All other work shall be inspected Monday through Friday between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm.
- 6. Additional conditions required for this specific project include:

Failure to comply with the directions, requirements and conditions of this encroachment permit will result in the applicant being issued a **stop work order** and required to cease all activity and withdraw from the City Property until the deficiency is corrected.

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FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of granting a permit or license for the purpose set forth herein, the Licensee hereby agrees, covenants, and binds said Licensee as follows:

- 1. The Licensee assumes the responsibility and all liability for any injury or damage to said Property, or to any person while using said Property in a lawful manner, caused by or arising out of the exercise of this permit or license.
- 2. All work done shall be at the sole cost and expense of the Licensee, and shall be done at such time and in such manner as to be least inconvenient to the traveling public, and as directed by the agent of the City. It is Licensee's responsibility to obtain prior written consent from any Lessee of the City at the time in possession of any Property included in this agreement. Work must be finished in the time specified on the permit.
- 3. When the proposed work is completed the Licensee shall repair the roadbed and replace the surfacing material thereon, and will leave said Property in as good a condition as it was prior to the start of work, so far as the Property is affected by the Licensee.
- 4. If the subject work of the permit fails to pass final inspection, the Licensee will remove or replace same within such time as specified by written notice from the City; or if at any time hereafter, any material used by the Licensee in replacing or reconstructing any part of said Property proves defective, the Licensee will replace same with the kind and quality of material which the City shall specify.
- 5. If the title and possession of any improvements placed upon the Property by the Licensee remains in said Licensee, the Licensee shall and will promptly perform all necessary repair work upon written notice from the City, and will not permit or allow any condition to exist which would be a hazard or source of danger to the traveling public.
- 6. At any time hereafter any permit or license granted in pursuance of this application may be revoked by the City and all rights there under terminated, and upon sufficient notice, the Licensee shall and will remove all improvements belonging to said Licensee.
- 7. In the event that work to be done under authority of the permit or license necessitates creation of any hazard or source of danger to any person or vehicle using said Property, said Licensee shall and will provide and maintain at all times during the existence of said hazard, sufficient barriers, danger signals, lanterns, detours, and shall be and will take such measures of precaution as the City shall direct.
- 8. A.R.S. 28-650 requires any contractor, firm or corporation performing work on roads, streets or highways, shall post and maintain at the work site until the work is complete or until such time as the governing body authorizes the removal, such warning signs, signals, markers and barricades in compliance with the MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES. A traffic control plan will be approved prior to construction.
- 9. The Licensee shall furnish suitable plans, maps, or diagrams showing the place, character and extent of the proposed work as deemed necessary by the City. Any changes in construction because of the change in design, errors, field conditions other than shown on the application, or any other factors requiring construction other than shown on the drawings will require immediate cessation of construction, and will require re-approval of this permit. Field conditions other than shown on the drawings, as well as failure to inform the City of Yuma, Engineering Services, of any changes may be cause for cancellation of this permit.
- 10. To conform with A.R.S., Chapter 2, Article 6.3, Sections 40-361.21 through 26 amended, 27, and 40-360.28 added, the Licensee shall contact the Blue Stake Center a minimum of three (3) working days prior to the planned start of construction.
- 11. Contractor shall comply with all State, Federal, and O.S.H.A. Safety, Health, and Welfare Regulations. Asbestos Certification shall be required for all cement asbestos water main construction.
