PY 2019 Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment 2
CARES Act – Round 2 of CDBG-CV Funding to Respond to COVID-19

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded the City of Yuma a \$775,575 in CDBG-CV funds as a result of the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The funds must be used to cover or reimburse allowable costs incurred before the award of funding (including prior to the signing of the CARES Act) to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19 and address the needs of low-and moderate income persons.

On October 7, 2020, Yuma City Council approved an Amendment to the PY2019/20 Action Plan.

This is the second substantial amendment to the 2019/2020 Action Plan. The first amendment was approved in April of 2020 to program funds received from the first tranche of CARES Act CDBG-CV funds, which was \$505,565.
