



William R. Higgins Murder

On November 8th 1988 at around 3:30 am, Yuma Police Officers responded to 968 South 1st Avenue reference a possible suicide. Upon arrival, Officers discovered Higgins had been shot and was deceased. At about 8:30 pm on November 7th, a loud 'bang' was heard and two males were seen leaving the residence shortly thereafter. One was a black male wearing a dark colored hat. He left the area in a red car with a white top. The other male was seen walking away. It is possible the 2nd male lived in the area. There is no given description of the 2nd male.
