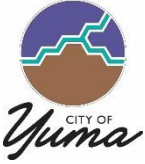

Frequently Asked Pool Rental Questions

When does my pool rental need to be paid off?

The balance due for the your aquatic rental **MUST** be paid in full, three weeks prior to your requested date in order to complete reservation. Refunds are not issued for cancellation or unused time.

What is “City Resident Credit” and why are there different fees for “City Residents” and “Non-City Residents”?

Various City of Yuma programs offered through Parks and Recreation Department are discounted slightly for City of Yuma residents. A Yuma Resident is defined as any person living within the corporate limits of the City of Yuma. This is a directive from Mayor and Council.

Why can't I rent an aquatic facility before June, or after July?

Although before June and after July is still “Yuma Hot”, a majority of aquatic staff (Lifeguards) still or will return to high school and college and are not available to work.

What is NOT allowed in Aquarium room, or pool area?

Any form of glass is not allowed at the facility as it poses a safety hazard for all (most people are barefoot). Alcoholic beverages, of ANY kind, are not allowed at the facility at any time, as it is a family atmosphere.

When can I submit my Pool Request form?

Pool Requests forms will not be accepted until January 01 of any given year and no later than three weeks prior to requested date (as available).

What times are an option for renting the Aquarium Room (VAC) during Open Swim?

- 1) Option 1, the entire window of 1:00 pm-6:00 pm; or
- 2) Option 2 1:00-3:00 pm, or
- 3) Option 3 3:30 pm-6:00 pm

Note: When window is broken up between two events, the 3:00-3:30 is reserved for cleaning.

What times are an option for renting the entire facility, privately (exclusive access)?

Any one of the municipal pools can be exclusively rented outside of City of Yuma scheduled program times (see digital activity guide for specific details at each facility).

- 1) The entire month of June
- 2) The entire month of July (except the last full week)
- 3) Times: Tuesday – Friday 6:30 pm – on (if available)
Saturday and Sunday Early am – 12:00 pm (if available)
6:30 pm – on (if available)

How big is the aquarium room and what amenities does it have:

- 1) The capacity of the Aquarium Room (banquet style) is 50 guests
- 2) The room size is 39 x 30
- 3) There are 18, 8ft. table

- 4) There are 40 folding chairs
- 5) The room theme is aquatic sea life in nature, mostly blue hues

- 6) The Aquarium room also includes the following:
 - i. Single sink
 - ii. 12 ft. long by 34 in. deep counter space (buffet style serving/food preparation)
 - iii. Upright refrigerator/freezer
 - iv. Microwave
 - v. Trash bin
 - vi. Power outlets (for small appliances such like crock pot/phone charger)
 - vii. Air conditioned
 - viii. DVD/VHS/Blu-ray player

Can I decorate the Aquarium Room for my celebration?

Yes, you are FREE to do some décor such as balloon arch, balloon bouquets, centerpieces, etc. No tape/tacks/putty on walls or ceiling. You can hang stuff on our thumb-tac board (2-4x4) or white board (18x4).

Can we bring toys and floaties to the pool?

Toys, arm floaties and rafts are not allowed at our aquatic facilities. The ONLY allowable aquatic devices are “US Coast Guard Approved” personal floatation devices.

- 1) Must be “VEST” Style City aquatic staff will not take the liability of assessing whether or not a PFD is properly sized for each individual.
- 2) Must be appropriate weight for said child.

Reasoning...should a life jacket be too loose, or otherwise not appropriate for body size, it could not only leave the swimmer unprotected, but falsely protected. Secondly, we wish to arm parents and supervisors of children to have a hands on/eyes on approach with the children they are responsible for....meaning active supervision of non-swimmers.

What are my guest payment options for using the Aquarium Room during Open Swim?

There are two ways to pay for your guests pool use during your family’s celebration:

- 1) Each guest pays for themselves upon entry, including non-swimming guests or,
- 2) Give the Pool Manager, upon your arrival, a guest list for the Cashier to check off attendance and you pay for guest total at end of your occupancy of the Aquarium Room.

Are there sitting areas around the pool?
