D. KIMLEY-HORN PRESENTATION

F. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

Robert Duffy gave an update on the ADA complaints the city has received from See-Click-Fix program. In January, there was a request for vegetation to be trimmed on the sidewalk. It was addressed the next day. On April 15, member of the public requested we conduct a survey on parking spaces throughout the parks in Yuma and replace handicap signage that is missing or defaced with graffiti. Member was contacted and informed of the survey that will be taking place to correct those items.

There was discussion regarding if a public service announcement can be made to announce where residents can address grievances. Public outreach will not be conducted until City council votes.

G. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Erin Eurek addressed the public parking concern, as part of the building and park evaluations, all associated accessible parking will be evaluated as part of the transition plan.
