Speakers should complete a Speaker Request Form for each item to be addressed.

"Call to the Public" comments are limited to non-agenda items that pertain to city business under the authority and legislative functions of the City Council.

When the City Clerk calls your name, please approach the podium, state your full name and address for the record, and speak into the microphone so the City Council may hear your comments. Speakers are limited to 3 minutes, with no more than 5 speakers permitted per topic/issue. The total time for "Call to the Public" is limited to 30 minutes, so please be considerate of how your time will affect other speakers.

Please note, that the City Council cannot discuss or take legal action on any matter raised unless it is properly notified for discussion and legal action. At the conclusion of the "Call to the Public," individual Councilmembers may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the City Council, ask staff to review a matter, or request that a matter be placed on a future agenda.

If you intend to submit any written materials to the City Council, please provide 12 copies to the City Clerk.
