b. Staff Update

i. Project Updates

Eric reported the following:

- ARPA Funded Projects:
 - East Mesa Community Parks is at 60% design and is over budget. The
 design of Phase I has been decreased to the construction of lake for
 reclaimed water, playground, and loop trail.
- Yuma Regional Medical Center is donating 3 inclusive playground pieces.
 - Kennedy Skate Park is only slightly over budget. Phase I will include 3
 primary elements stunt s, bowl, and pump track.
- A virtual meeting is scheduled for December 14, 2023, at 5:30 pm.
- The design is at 90% and we are scheduled to break ground in February. The construction will take about 6 months.
 - Kennedy Hockey Rink dasher boards have been ordered.
 - Looking at new floor options.
