E. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

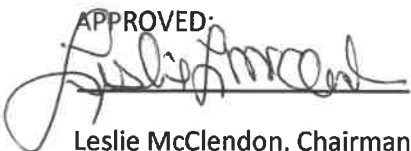
Robert Duffy provided an update on the ADA concerns the city has received from the SeeClickFix program. Three citizen's reported issues in June. One was mistakenly reported as an ADA concern. The second was listed as loose gravel at the Gateway park. Parks & Recreation assessed the situation and contacted the citizen and listed the item closed. Robert Duffy will follow-up with Parks & Recreation. The third concern was for a lack of sidewalk on one side of the street on 15th St east of Arizona Ave. The area is currently undeveloped.
